Once they move all hosted sites off UpLink Earth, we will have to make a decision if we want to stay with the County's new platform but it would cost approximately \$3,800-\$7,600.00 over the term of a 5-year agreement or contract with the new company for our hosting services. Currently our website being with the County is free. Ms. Santore reached out to the BBMUA's IT company to see if they have any recommendations and will keep the board informed of what she finds.

The prices remained the same as the last contract in 2023. Therefore, a resolution was adopted to enter into a contract with GE Mechanical for vac truck services as quoted.
