ENGINEER'S REPORT: #1 Email from Robert Smith of Remington & Vernick regarding the final requisition for the NJ I-Bank project. As a result of delays in the project completion due to material delays, Remington & Vernick has incurred additional inspection costs over the approved amount. The additional cost through the end of February total \$16,571.84 in inspection and contract administration fees. If there are funds available Remington would like to forward and invoice to the MUA.

#2 Email from Robert Smith of Remington & Vernick regarding the Buena Vista Campground. The Campground requested the MUA to allow them to discharge a combination of sewage/rainwater/groundwater from their on-site septic tanks into their pump station and pump it into the MUA sanitary sewer system. Mr. Smith's office has been working with Plant Superintendent Alan Zorzi to evaluate the impact to the treatment process. Alan has consulted the NJDEP on this matter. Based on the collective discussions, Remington & Vernick has prepared a draft contract for review by the BBMUA Board and the BBMUA Solicitor for review.
