The problem that we have now is the entire time they have been doing takeout during the pandemic no water usage was being registered. They were charged a minimum water bill of \$63.50 and a minimum sewer bill of \$136.25, however the sewer billing is based off of water usage. Unfortunately we have no way of knowing exactly how much water was used to bill them accurately.
