It was found that the equivalent dosage to the Zeta Lyte 21, their Zetag 8125 provided a larger faster flock and yielded a faster free-water release with far lower filtrate solids. Coyne provided the MUA with a sample in December 2013. After trying the product in use with our belt filter press it was found to be non-compatible with our process.
